2. Report of Activities of the NBU Alumni Association

(16/03/2021 - 19/03/2022)

2.1. Condolence

To the best of our knowledge, during the period since the last AGM held on 15/3/21, we have lost the following Members:

- (3) Dr.Bikash Ch.Roy, Professor of Bengali & Dean of Gour Banga University on 26/4/21.

- (4) Dr.Prithwiraj Jha, Principal of Surendranath Mahavidyalaya, raiganj on 5/5/21.
- (5) Mr. Rathindranath Bhattacharya, Former Teacher of Bani Mandir Rly. H.S. School, Siliguri on 20/11/21.

Meetings were held online on the following day to condole the sad demise of the Members and Condolence Resolutions have been sent to the bereaved families.

Yet, it is obvious that we do not know many other cases where alumni of NBU, whether Members of NBUAA or not, have breathed their last. The Association pays its respect to the memory of the friends we have lost.

2.2. Relief Work during Covid Pandemic:

The Executive Committee resolved on 23/5/21 to issue an appeal to the Members for voluntary contribution during the Phase II of Covid Pandemic that engulfed and caused severe devastation in West Bengal and all across the country since April, 2021. The Appeal was circulated to each Member by email and Whatsup as well as through our social media platforms like three Whatsup Groups (NBU Alumni Association, NBUAA Family I, NBUAA Family II) and Facebook Page (Nbu Alumni Association). Rs.1.84,607.00 was collected till September, 2021. The fund was utilized in the best possible manner through camps organized by the Chapters, namely the Chapters of Siliguri, Coochbehar, Alipurduar, Jalpaiguri, Dakshin Dinajpur, Uttar Dinajpur, Malda and Hills. Several relief camps were organized in remote locations, occasionally in collaboration with local NGOs and cultural organizations, to reach the poorest of the poor whose livelihoods were deeply dented by the pandemic. Cooked food, food items, mask, sanitizers, disinfectants, clothes and reading materials to the children were distributed. In addition to these efforts, Rs.5000.00 was donated to Bhimbhar Snehasram of Bidhan Nagar, an orphanage-cum-educational institute.

An Audited Statement of expenditure is separately attached.

2.3. Letters and Deputations:

- 2.3.1. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, NBU was requested by letter dated 29/4/21 to open a Vaccination Centre in NBU Campus and set up a Safe Home for persons infected by corona virus. It was requested that access to these facilities be extended to the alumni who reside in the viscinity.
- 2.3.2. Attention of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, West Bengal was drawn to the harassment caused to the people at handful of Vaccination Centres in North Bengal . She was requested by letter dated 10/5/21 to launch Community Vaccination Centres in North Bengal for easy and seamless mass vaccination that was the only ray of hope to prevent and be protected from corona virus transmission.
- 2.3. 3. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India was requested by letter dated 30/6/21 for
- 1. That a Statue of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose be installed at the India Gate Canopy at the heart of New Delhi. There lies an empty Canopy, where once stood the statue of King George V, near India Gate adjoining the War Memorial to our Soldiers. The location is situated on Rajpath, about 150 meters east of India Gate. There exists one 73 foot Cupola, inspired by a sixth-century pavilion from Mahabalipuram. The canopy was constructed in 1936 and had a statue of King George V, which was removed in 1968 and the site is vacant since then.
- 2. That the Birth Day of the legendary Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose be declared as a National Holiday to enable the countrymen to commemorate the occasion and be inspired by the noble ideals left behind by one of the greatest sons of India.

The first proposal is still pending. We have been informed vide letter of the Ministry of Culture dated 6/1/22 that it has been referred to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for consideration.

The second proposal has been regretted vide letter of the Ministry of Personnel, P.G. & Pensions dated 27/9/21 on the ground that the 7th Central Pay Commission which is the mandated authority in this respect, has decided to maintain status quo regarding National Holidays.

2.3. 4. A deputation of the Office-bearers including Dr. Ananda Gopal Ghosh presented a memorandum on 9/8/21 to the Vice-Chancellor requesting him to kindly consider the following steps:

- The Diamond Jubilee Year of NBU will commence on June 1, 2022 which date is just a few months away. This is a landmark event and should be celebrated to take stock of the past and draw a blueprint of future expansion. The NBUAA is ready to be associated and contribute in this cause as a stake holder of NBU.
- 2. To install a newly sculpted Statue of Raja Rammohan Roy in place of the existing one which is already 56 yrs old and not in a good shape. This will be a befitting work in commemoration of the 250th Birth Anniversary of the greatest Icon of Indian Renaissance.
- 3. To recover the navigability of the Magurmari River that flows through the Campus by dredging, de-silting and other measures in the interest of conserving the ecosystem in the Campus. The NBUAA has some members having domain knowledge and agree.
- 4. To set up a Bio-Diversity Park in the Campus for teaching-learning & research purpose considering the endowment of unique natural resources in the Campus. The NBUAA is ready to be associated and contribute in this project. We are willing to prepare a DPR for consideration.
- 5. A Liaison Committee may be constituted with representatives of NBU and NBUAA for periodic interactions and creating a forum where feedback of the alumni may be placed. There was such a Committee during the early years of NBUAA that was established in October, 2001.
- 6. Traffic Department of Siliguri Police Commissioner may be requested to install a Traffic Post near Gate No.2.






